Dear Church Family:

As you have probably heard by now, we will be able to meet this Sunday! As we move forward in opening the church doors, there will be some new guidelines to keep everyone safe and healthy.

We as a church will be following the guidelines set by the state and county and will have a plan of action that will work best for our church.

1. At this time, we will only be having church worship service. There will be no meeting for Sunday School, Bible Study, or other activities at church. Sunday School and all other Bibles studies will be online only for safety and will be added back as soon as possible.
2. We will be entering and exiting the building through the front doors and the doors on the south side. Please let the door greeters (who will be wearing gloves) open and close doors for you. This will help in reducing the spread of any germs. There will be ushers available to seat you for the service. We will be following the social distancing guidelines as set by the county and state.
3. If you are in the high-risk category, feel unsure about returning, or you feel ill, then please stay home. Continue to worship with us by watching the service on Facebook live. We want you to be safe and to take all the proper precautions.
4. Hand sanitizer will available. Hand washing with soap and water is required after restroom use, sneezing/coughing, or touching your face, etc.
5. Extra cleaning and disinfecting procedures have been put into place as well.
6. Face masks and gloves are optional and not mandatory at this time; however, if you feel safer wearing them, please feel free to do so. We do not have masks or gloves to distribute, so please know that everyone attending may not be wearing them.

We are praying that these changes are temporary and one day soon we will not have to practice them. But for now, let's do what we can to protect our church families' safety.
